

- The County's appeal to the Maryland Court of Appeals decision in the Absence Control Pol icy case was heard on June 4, 2014. On July 30, 2014 we received an unfavorable decision. The court reversed the Court of Special Appeals and ruled in favor of the County Administra tion.
- The County's briefs to the Court of Special Appeals in the Retiree Subsidy case were due August 1, 2014 and were submitted.

PENSION COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

 At the July Pension Board of Trustees meeting the Board approved 41 total retirements. Two of those were from the police department.

POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE ~Steve Comegna~

- The Political Action Committee met on Thursday July 10, 2014 to discuss the results of the June 24th primary elections and to format plans for moving forward into the November 4, 2014 General Election.
- The committee reviewed our endorsements for the primary election. We endorsed twenty-five (25) candidates for various local offices. Twenty-three (23) were winners in their respective races.
- The committee also continued with the endorsement process. We examined the 7th District Baltimore County Council race. The committee examined the two primary winners, their re-

sumes, their organizations/ campaigns and the results of their interviews. The committee voted unanimously to endorse Joe Di-Cara in the November General Election.

- The motion to endorse Joe Di-Cara was presented to the Executive Board of Directors on Monday July 21, 2014. The Executive Board was also unanimous in their vote to endorse him.
- At the July 2014 General Business Meeting, the membership concurred with the committee and the board. The vote was again unanimous for the endorsement of Joe Dicara for Baltimore County Council in District # 7.
