GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE ~Ryan Massey~

 On 6-30-21 a Class Action Grievance (Alan Hamby) was filed in reference pension credit calculation for membership in the Maryland National Guard. The grievance is currently at Step 3. Jim Ruckle from the Office of Law has been assigned the case. Hearing is scheduled for August 26th.

HEALTHCARE REVIEW COMMITTEE ~Mike DiCara~

- A meeting of the HCRC and the County Administration was held on July 12th. The County announced their plan to move open enrollment back to October this year, but have not yet finalized the 2022 rates.
- Prior to open enrollment, the County will also release an ondemand webinar to assist Medicare eligible retirees navigate the Cigna Medicare Advantage Plan. This will be available on the County's website.

- Our healthcare consultant discussed the possibility of a joint education effort between Labor and the County to help increase enrollment in the high deductible/HSA plans, which can save our members hundreds of dollars a year in premiums.
- Finally, the County announced a \$70 million appropriation to the OPEB Account for FY 2022 to fund retiree healthcare.

SOCIAL MEDIA COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~


