#### Reminder for Retirees at Tax Time

The Healthcare Enhancement for Local Public Safety (HELPS) Retirees Act allows a deduction of up to \$3,000 annually for health care and long term care insurance premiums. The federal law went into effect Jan. 1, 2007. The deduction is for the federal income tax return only. More information can be obtained from the Lodge 4 website in the Contracts & Legislation section. Also, IRS publications have information on the topic that refer to pensions of retired public safety officers.

## GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

- There were no grievances filed this month.
  - We did have an issue in precinct #8 involving the maintenance of the exercise equipment. Under Section 5.9 of the MOU it states that "The department shall continue to maintain the physical fitness equipment already in place." The members at Precinct #8 had submitted the paperwork to have the equipment repaired or replaced back in April 2014 and again in August 2014 without any results. I forwarded the copies of the paperwork and the responses our members received from the department budget office to Colonel Burris. I also sent him a copy of section 5.9 in the MOU. He responded back the same day in writing that he would look into the issue and acknowledged it was a contract issue. A week later he responded back and said the process to repair or replace the equipment had not been completed but that he was trying to assist in getting it done.

in a grievance that has been ongoing for several years. They were appealing the November 5, 2013 order to restore the health care subsidy rate for the affected retirees, the March 6, 2014 order awarding the reimbursement to be paid to the affected retirees and the April 17, 2014 order awarding interest on the money owed to the affected retirees. The appeals were consolidated

- and a hearing was held on November 3, 2014.
- On December 17, 2014 the Court of Special Appeals issued a very comprehensive and detailed decision, which denied all of the County's appeals for a second time and ruled in favor of the retirees and FOP Lodge #4.
- At this time the County has the option to file for a Writ of Certiorari to the Maryland Court of Appeals. The deadline was February 2, 2015.
- In the Brandt Bradford case, the ERS/County has filed an appeal to the Court of Special Appeals.
   No briefing schedule has been set.

### PENSION COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

At the January Pension Board of Trustees meeting the Board approved 43 total retirements. Six of those were from the police department.

# POLICY REVIEW COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

The Special Order for the Taser Camera System Pilot Program the Department is implementing has been completed. The finalized policy allows for involved officers to view the video before making any written or oral statements in a police report or any investigation. This will ensure accuracy in any accompanying documentation and subsequent interview that may follow in a use of force investigation. The Department is still going to allow members the availability to "opt out" of the TASER certification if they choose. If a member does get trained and is certified, he/she will be required to carry the TASER.

In January, the Department convened a Body Camera Workgroup at the direction of the County Executive to discuss Body Worn Cameras. The FOP has positions on the committee to provide input and perspective. We will report on this as further information comes forward. A committee report is due in 90 days.

#### **GOOD OF THE ORDER**

During the month of January, FOP Lodge #4 sent seven (7) cards and flower arrangements to bereaving members. Three (3) donations were made in lieu of flowers at the request of bereaving members. One (1) basket was sent to a member recovering from hospitalization. Twelve (12) thank you cards were received.
