



DONATION REVIEW ~Paul Merkle~

HEALTH CARE COMMITTEE ~Steve Comegna~

• The legislation that was submitted by the Baltimore County Executive recognizing the Health Care Review Committee as the official bargaining agent for health care benefits in Baltimore County was passed by the Baltimore County Council on Tuesday February 19, 2013.

LEGAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

On January 18, 2013 The Maryland Court of Appeals denied the "Motion for Reconsideration" that was filed by Baltimore • County on December 7, 2012 in the Retiree Subsidy case. There are no other avenues for appeal by the County. The Court of Appeals issued an order to the Court of Special Appeals to reverse itself and AFFIRM the Baltimore County Circuit Court and Arbitrator's decision in favor of the Fraternal Order of Police. On February 26, 2013 The Court of Special Appeals issued and order reversing itself and entering a judgment that the Baltimore County Circuit Court decision be affirmed. The County is currently working on calculating the amount of reimbursement to the affected mem-They must also return bers.



those members to their proper health care subsidy that was in place upon retirement. In addition, our law firm is preparing a fee petition to recover our legal fees in this case. The County has until April 30, 2013 to respond to our fee petition.


On January 31, 2013 Brother Ryan Massey's trial board was held at the Public Safety Building. Brother Massey was sustained by IAS for 5 separate integrity allegations. These allegations were initiated by a County Attorney, Suzanne Berger, after a worker's compensation hearing almost two years earlier. The hearing lasted 3 days and the Department's witnesses included testimony from an "expert" from the County Worker's Compensation office, • the IAS investigator and a physician contracted by the County, Dr. Kenneth Tepper. After the Department's case was concluded, Brother Massey testified as the only witness on his behalf

(excluding character witnesses). At the conclusion of the hearing, the trial board members found him NOT GUILTY on every charge. There were some very disturbing issues that surfaced during this entire investi-These issues ranged gation. from the documentation of the initial injury, questions about who made the complaint to IAS, how the investigation was conducted, and how any of these allegations were sustained. The FOP has obtained the record for the proceeding and is having it transcribed. Once we receive the transcribed record, more information will be disseminated and further action may be taken to prevent this type conduct from occurring again.

On February 25, 2013 the Legal Advisory Committee members met to discuss a request from Brother Damon White for reimbursement of attorney fees. After discussing the case and reviewing the request, a motion was made to not approve the

request. The motion received a proper second and passed. Brother White may seek reimbursement from the Lodge after his case has concluded, if he wins, as stated in the bylaws.

- The second item discussed was the reimbursement of attorney fees to Brother Massey. The members unanimously approved a total reimbursement of \$7,500.00.
- The Stanley Siedlecki case was heard in Baltimore County Circuit Court on January 22, 2012 in front of Judge Cox. On March 7, 2013 we received a ruling in favor of Baltimore County.
- On June 28, 2012 the County filed an appeal to the Court of Special Appeals of Judge Cox's Circuit Court decision on our Writ of Mandamus on the Employee Relations Act regarding changes to the Absence Control Policy. No hearing date has been set.
- The Employee Relations Act (County Executive Jim Smith, Binding Arbitration) case was heard on September 9, 2011 at the Court of Special Appeals. We are still waiting for a decision.
- The Brandt Bradford case was scheduled for March 6, 2013.
 The case was postponed due to the closing of County offices because of weather.
- The James Laboard case is scheduled for Motions on April 12, 2013 and the case has been rescheduled for June 17, 2013 in Baltimore County Circuit.
- We currently have six (6) trial boards scheduled for the first 5 months of 2013.



PENSION COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

The Baltimore County Employees' Retirement System Board of Trustees Meeting was held on February 12, 2013. Forty-two (42) total retirements, thirty (30) service, five (5) DROP, six (6) vested and one (1) lump sum death benefit were approved.

POLICY REVIEW COMMITTEE ~Dave Rose~

The committee received three (3) policies to review this month. Issues were identified with two (2) of the policies. Both refer to changes to modified duty within the Department and the County. Within the Department, there are changes to Administrative Manual 7-4.3 Modified Duty. The committee is currently reviewing it. No meeting with the department has been scheduled. At the County level, there have been changes to the Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual. Section 9.13.1 and 9.13.2. On February 7, 2013 the FOP delivered a "Request to Bargain" letter to the Director of the Office of Human Resources, George Gay. Since then, I have communicated with him about the request and he stated he had delivered our request to the County Office of Law and we will be receiving a response.

There are some serious issues that need to be discussed and resolved with these changes to Modified Duty, both at the County level and Department level. Currently there is nothing explaining any of the effects these changes will have on our members. We believe these concerns should be resolved before either of these policies takes effect. If these issues can be resolved we may be able to prevent future litigation and grievances.

GOOD OF THE ORDER

- Members were advised of upcoming retirement parties in March.
- Treasurer Bob Caskey advised that Lodge 4 will hold a raffle for 4 tickets to the first night-time Orioles game to benefit James LaBoard. Contact the Lodge to purchase tickets.
