President's Message

I want to thank everyone for their kind words of encouragement as I move forward as President of the organization. It is an honor to represent the professional police officers of Baltimore County. Your new team has an aggressive agenda for this term. One of the bigger issues is securing a DROP (Deferred Retirement Option Program) for those employees without one. We are proud to announce that we are bringing forth a DROP for ratification for the post 2007 hires. If they ratify this DROP, it will provide our younger officers with a financial incentive that will help them in their retirement years.

We are still monitoring and considering options to fight discriminatory COVID testing practices. The county refuses to test all employees. In September of 2021, our membership passed motions making our official position that we are opposed to testing, but if testing is to occur, it is to be performed on all employees. Our members have brought forth many concerns about the Five Medicine company that is performing these tests. Among the concerns: the company lost its license to practice business in DC, the CEO has been sanctioned in the medical community, there is a pop-up storefront in Halethorpe, and the employees are temporary hires. Additionally, the county rushed this contract through 3 days before the end of the state of emergency so that the Baltimore County Council and the community would have no say in the matter.

As the Maryland General Assembly gears back up, we have hired retired Senator Bobby Zirkin to represent Lodge 4 in Annapolis and here at home. Bob has been a friend to our Lodge for many years. He will bring behind-the-scenes insight to many of our concerns about legislation.

Lodge 4 has an App! You have read about it before, but now is the time to download it. Instructions can be found on page 5. The App is only open to FOP members. Moving forward, our goal is for quicker communication using the App's features. We will begin posting meeting minutes, Lodge Officer activities, and my message on the App shortly after our general membership meetings. As we progress, we look to revamp *The Fourword* newsletter to make it more informational and article-centered, eliminating the need for the minutes to be included. For those members that don't know what an App is, we will come up with an alternative so they can still read about our meetings. All this requires By-laws changes, so you will know about it before it happens.

Again, I would like to thank everyone for their support. Lieutenant Dave Sweren and Detective Chris Hodnicki have agreed to support me with the everyday lodge business. Please reach out to any of us with your idea, concerns or issues.

- On the Google Play Store (Android) or App Store (Apple)
- Search for and Download the "NFOP App"
- Open the App and select "Sign Up"
- Enter your Personal email address (gmail, yahoo, etc.) NO Department email addresses
- Create a password.
- On the next screen, populate all required (*) fields.
 - Lodge State = Maryland
 - Lodge Name = Lodge 4 Baltimore County
 - Lodge Number = 004
 - o Membership Number = the number on the back of your National ID card

If you can't find it, call the Lodge and we can track it down for you

- Enter all required info and click "Sign Up", your info will be verified by Clowder/National.
- You'll be automatically assigned to the Lodge 4 App as "Pending" until we can mark you approved.
- You don't need to allow Location Services, but we recommend accepting Push Notifications, so that you'll know you have something to read in the App.
- When you receive a notification from the App, open it. Newer posts and info show at the top of the feed.
- To see the info specific to Lodge 4, select the "My Groups" button toward the top of the page.
- Next, select MD004 and tap the check mark at the top of the page and hit the check mark at the top of the
 page. This will limit what you see during this session to just the Lodge 4 posts.

You can view all of the National Lodge posts, at any time, by selecting "All Users – National FOP", but selecting MD004 keeps it easier to find our specific info.

Android Users: To see additional features, tap on the three small lines on the left side, toward the top of the page. This will show you a host of other options.

Apple Users: To see additional features, on the first page of the App, tap on the "More" field at the right side, at the bottom of the page. This will show you a host of other options.
